The subject includes all areas and styles of, and approaches to, philosophy. The subject covers all areas of philosophy, including but not limited to (listed alphabetically): 19th and 20th century European philosophy including phenomenology, existentialism, critical theory, hermeneutics, and deconstruction, aesthetics, applied philosophy, epistemology, ethics including applied ethics feminist philosophy, history of philosophy including ancient, medieval, modern and recent, logic metaphysics, non-Western philosophy, philosophy of language, philosophy of mathematics philosophy of mind, philosophy of religion, philosophy of science, political and social philosophy teaching philosophy. This list is illustrative rather than exhaustive: it does not reflect any judgements about the relative significance of the subject areas, nor does it specify 'fields'.
